The Ridge to Reef program at UC Irvine is soliciting applications for Fall 2018 admission. R2R is a new National Science Foundation Research Traineeship (NRT) designed to train the next generation of scholars to solve environmental problems affecting terrestrial, freshwater, marine, and urban ecosystems from the mountains to the coastal ocean.

PROGRAM FEATURES

- Training for diverse careers in environmental science and management
- Open to Masters or PhD students at UC Irvine working on environmental problems anywhere along the ridge to reef continuum
- Research partnerships with non-profits, agencies, and industry
- Training program:
 - Core courses in communication, policy, and ecosystem management
 - Summer short courses and research orientation
 - Problem-based seminar in environmental solutions
 - Community engagement opportunities
 - Internship experience with partner organizations
 - Career skills workshops
- Interact with a broad range of faculty, student colleagues, and practitioners
- Fellowship opportunities for PhD students (\$34,000/yr + tuition/fees)
